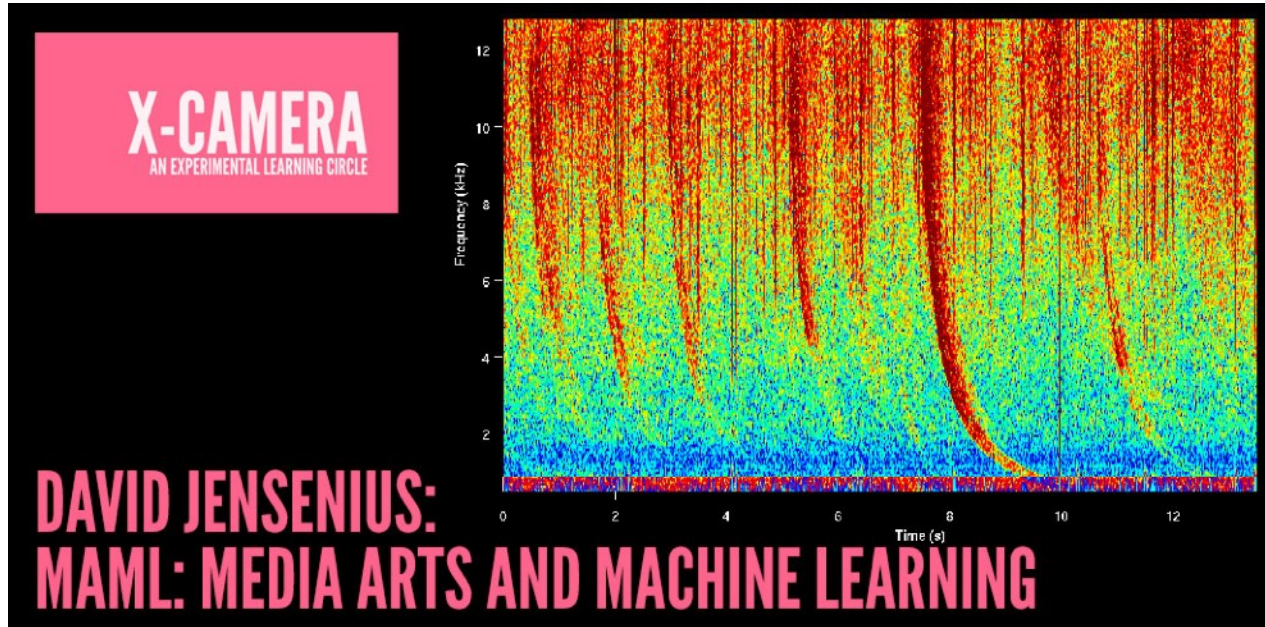


X-CAMERA SPEAKER SERIES



David Jensenius: MAML: Media Arts and Machine Learning Friday, June 7, 2019, 12:00 noon

A brief introduction to what machine learning is, followed by examples of how it is being used by different artists. The talk will also discuss experiments David is doing with machine learning and sound.

David Jensenius is a composer and media artist who utilizes collage, phonography, and electronics to create sonically challenging listening experiences. David frequently collaborates, he is a member of SPURSE, a research and design collaborative that catalyzes critical issues into collective action, and a founder of the improvisational group Polish Club. David is on the board of NUMUS, a contemporary music concert series in Kitchener, Ontario. Through a playful transformation of conceptual and material systems, David develops problems worth having, engaging across scales and complexities both human and nonhuman. David's work has been exhibited throughout Canada and internationally.
